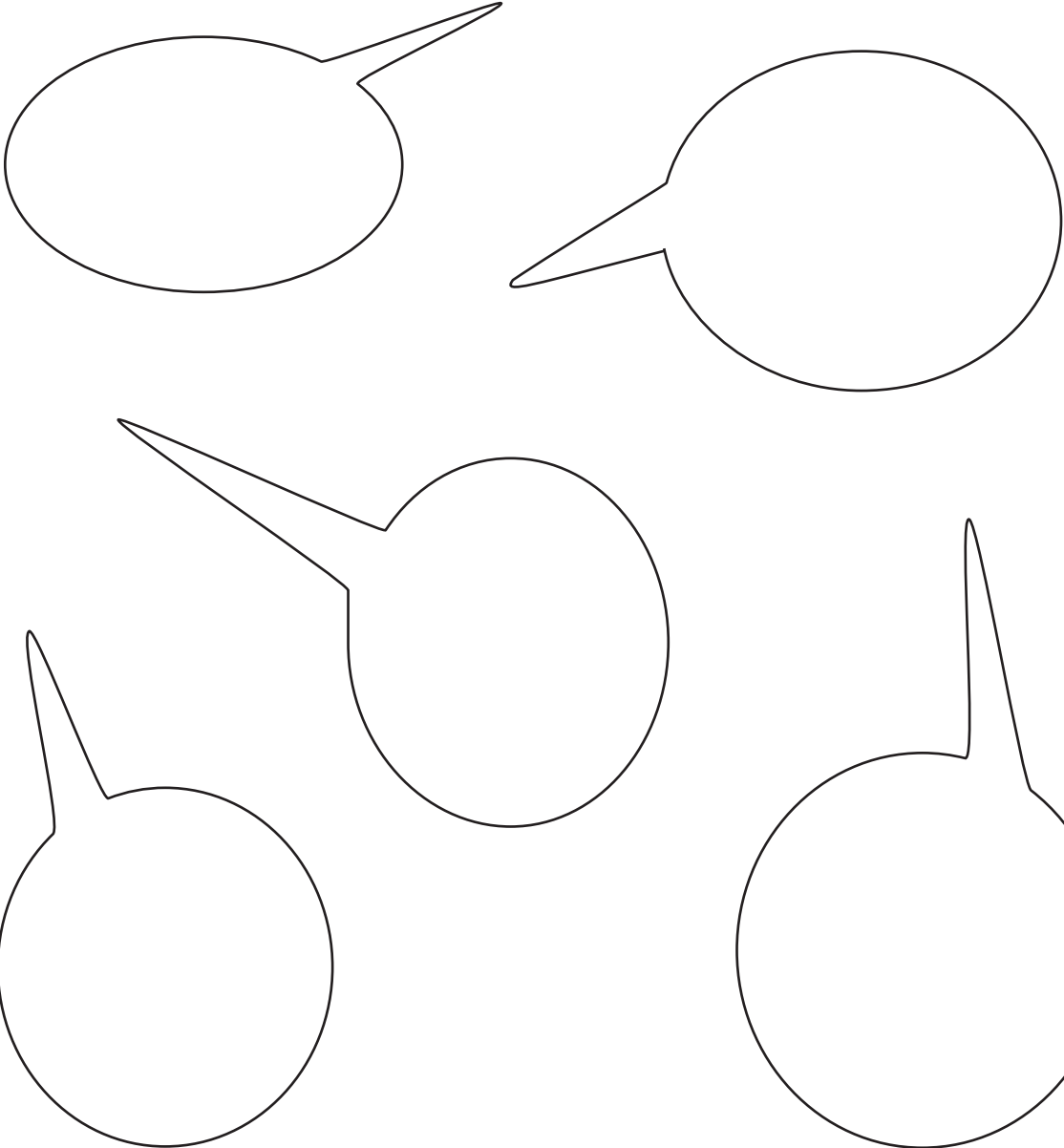
In the Bible we read about many miracles that Jesus performed.

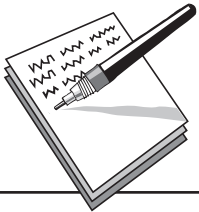
Here is one dictionary definition of a miracle:

A man's servant is healed.

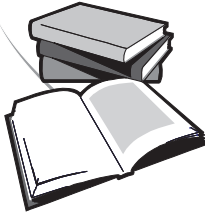
